

*Amended Rules — Standing Orders Ordinance 1951.*

AMENDED RULES for the conduct of all business coming before the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney known as Standing Orders.

WHEREAS Standing Orders were passed by the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the year 1936 and were duly assented to in writing.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the same.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney rules as follows:

1. The said Standing Orders are hereby amended as follows:—

By inserting after the word "AND" where secondly appearing in Standing Order 42 the following words:

"the vote taken without further debate unless any member desires to speak in opposition or to move an amendment when the debate shall proceed."
