AN ORDINANCE amending the Church of England National  
Emergency Fund Memorial Centre Mortgaging  
Ordinance 1947.

WHEREAS by the Church of England National Emergency Fund Memorial Centre Mortgaging Ordinance 1947 (hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance) authority was given to the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney to obtain from time to time an advance or advances of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of £32,000; on the security of the lands therein described. AND WHEREAS it is now expedient that authority be given to increase the amount of the advance or advances by a sum not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of £39,000. Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and in the place of the said Synod ordains declares rules and directs as follows:—

1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts recited in the said Principal Ordinance it is expedient that the Principal Ordinance be amended as hereinafter set out:—

2. Clause 1 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by deleting the words and figures "£32,000"; and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures "£39,000";

3. This Ordinance may be styled and cited as "Church of England National Emergency Fund Memorial Centre Mortgaging Ordinance 1947, Amending Ordinance 1948."

4. The principal Ordinances as amended by this Ordinance may be styled and cited as "Church of England National Emergency Fund Memorial Centre Mortgaging Ordinance 1947-1948."
