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*General Assessment Ordinance, 1967*

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No. 32, 1967.

AN ORDINANCE to assess Parishes, Provisional Parishes and Provisional Districts to provide contributions authorised by the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959, as amended.

WHEREAS by or under the provisions of the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended provision is made inter alia that prior to each session of Synod the Standing Committee shall prepare a Statement showing the sums to be contributed annually by each Parish, Provisional Parish and Provisional District for the purposes set out therein based on an assessment in the manner provided by the said Ordinance AND WHEREAS it is expedient to fix an assessment for a period of one year to take effect as from the first day of April, 1968 NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers and under the provisions of the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended hereby Ordains and Rules as follows:-

1. The estimates which appear in the First Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby approved.

2. The Synod hereby fixes an amount of \$157,765 as an assessment for the period of one year from the 1st day of April 1968 to 31st day of March 1969 in accordance with the details set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. The said assessment shall operate in accordance with the provisions of the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended.
