

Maroubra Ordinance 1992

No 43, 1992

An Ordinance to vary trusts on which certain property is held and to make provision for the application of that property.

Whereas

A. Certain property (the "property") comprising the balance of the proceeds of the sale of the land referred to in the First Schedule of the St John's Maroubra Ordinance 1979 and accumulated income is church trust property held on the trusts set out in clause 3 of the St John's Maroubra Ordinance 1979.

B. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts on which the property is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is inexpedient to deal with or apply the property for the same or like purposes in those trusts and it is expedient that the trusts be varied as provided for hereinafter.

Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod Hereby Ordains Declares Directs and Rules as follows.

1. This ordinance may be cited as the "Maroubra Ordinance 1992".
2. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts on which the property is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is inexpedient to deal with or apply the property for the same or like purposes in those trusts and it is expedient that the trusts be varied as provided for in clauses 3 and 4.
3. The Property Trust is authorised to pay the property to the Churchwardens of St John's Maroubra.
4. The Churchwardens of St John's Maroubra shall apply the property and income earned thereon towards meeting the costs of the promotion of this ordinance and thereafter towards the repair renovation and maintenance of parish buildings.
