An Ordinance to amend the "Old Sydney Burial Ground Moneys Ordinance of 1904."

Whereas by the provisions of the "Old Sydney Burial Ground Moneys Ordinance of 1904" (hereinafter referred to as the Ordinance) the proceeds of a certain resumption were vested in the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (hereinafter referred to as "the said Trust"). AND whereas the said resumption moneys together with unapplied income, totalling in all One thousand five hundred pounds have, with the approval of the Archbishop of Sydney, been treated as Capital moneys, and in addition there are certain other moneys held by "the said Trust" as income.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Clause 4 of the said Ordinance now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod ordains and declares as follows:—

- 1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the said trusts it has become inexpedient to carry out or observe such trusts to the extent to which the same are varied by this Ordinance and it is expedient that such trusts should be varied accordingly.
- 2. Of the funds referred to in the said Ordinance One thousand five hundred pounds (£1,500 0s. 0d.), shall be deemed to be and shall be held as capital and the balance shall be treated as accumulated income and shall be applied accordingly.
- 3. Clause 4 of the said Ordinance is hereby amended by omitting the word "Parochial."
- 4. This Ordinance shall be styled and cited as the "Old Sydney Burial Ground Moneys Ordinance of 1904 Amending Ordinance 1946."
