R. H. Reberts Estate Sale Ordinance 1940 Amending Ordinance 1950.

No. 10, 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to declare the trusts of certain moneys held pursuant to the sale of certain property referred to in the R. H. Roberts Estate Sale Ordinance 1940.

Whereas the Church of England Froperty Trust Diocese of Sydney sold all its Estate right title and interest in the property referred to in the before-mentioned Ordinance for the sum of £100. AND WHEREAS the said Trust stands possessed of the proceeds of sale upon the trust contained in the said Will, viz., for such purpose as the said Trust might think fit and such proceeds are held by the said Trust in accordance with the provisions of the Church of England Trust Property Act. AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the trusts should be declared. Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod ordains, rules and directs as follows:—

- 1. The said proceeds and all accumulations arising therefrom shall be held upon trust for the purposes of the Church of England at Gilbulla, Menangle.
- 2. The said trust shall apply the said proceeds and accumulations arising therefrom in and towards the payment of the principal due to the Bank of New South Wales in connection with the mortgage secured over the property known as "Gilbulla" at Menangle.
- 3. This Ordinance shall be cited as the "R. H. Roberts Estate Sale Ordinance 1940 Amending Ordinance 1950."
