

*Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance Amendment  
Ordinance, 1959*

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No. 16, 1959

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958.

WHEREAS it is expedient to continue the provisions of the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958 (hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance) subject to certain amendments as hereinafter provided and to fix the assessment in pursuance thereof for one year to take effect from the 1st day of April, 1960, AND WHEREAS for the said year an estimated amount of £45,408 will be required in accordance with the budget set out in the First Schedule hereto AND WHEREAS it is expedient to fix the assessment at £45,408 to take effect from 1st day of April, 1960, to 31st day of March, 1961. AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Principal Ordinance to authorise the assessment for the year 1960/61. NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains and Directs as follows:—

1. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by suspending so much of the provisions of such Ordinance as are inconsistent with this Ordinance and by fixing an assessment for the purposes referred to in such Ordinance for one year from 1st day of April 1960 to 31st day of March, 1961.

2. Clause 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the word "income" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "net receipts" and by deleting the words and figures "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures "the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959."

3. The budget which appears in the First Schedule to this Ordinance is hereby approved and the Second Schedule of the Principal Ordinance is amended accordingly.

4. Subject to the provisions of clause 2 hereof, the Synod hereby fixes an amount of £45,408 as an assessment for the period of one year from 1st day of April 1960 to the 31st day of March 1961 in accordance with the details set out in the Second Schedule hereto and the Third Schedule of the Principal Ordinance is amended accordingly.
