

ST ALBAN'S FIVE DOCK ORDINANCE 1989

No 8, 1989

AN ORDINANCE to vary the trusts on which certain property is held.

WHEREAS

A. By his will, Thomas Edward Camburn left \$2,000 for the churchwardens for the time being of St Alban's Church at Five Dock to be held by the said churchwardens as trustees and to be invested in Commonwealth Bonds and to use the income therefrom for Sunday School prizes and picnics for the St Alban's Church at Five Dock.

B. By reason of circumstances which have arisen it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the said trusts to the extent that the same are hereby varied.

NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod **HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES** as follows:

1. This ordinance may be cited as "St Alban's Five Dock Ordinance 1989".

2. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts set forth in the said will it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same to the extent that the same are hereby varied.

3. The income from the said \$2,000 (including all income which has accumulated thereon) shall be applied for such purposes of St Alban's Church Five Dock as the churchwardens and incumbent shall determine from time to time.
