An Ordinance to vary determine and appoint the application of the rents and profits of the old parsonage site of the Church of St. James situate at Sydney in the County of Cumberland as set out in the "Saint James' Parsonage Act 1912" and Ordinances thereon and for other purposes incidental thereto.

WHEREAS by the "St. James Parsonage Act 1912 Ordinance of 1931" it was enacted that for the period from the first day of April One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one to the thirtyfirst day of March One thousand nine hundred and thirty six subsection (c) of section 5 of the St. James' Parsonage Act should be read as if after the word "Year" the words "a sum less by three hundred pounds per annum reckoned quarterly than" were inserted therein AND ALSO for the same period sub-section (d) of the same Act and section should be read as if the words "for the period of fifteen years" were omitted therefrom and the following words added to the end thereof "and a sum of three hundred pounds per annum reckoned quarterly in and towards the payment of rates and taxes payable in respect of the St. James' Sydney Parish Hall" AND WHEREAS by the St. James' Parsonage Act 1912 Ordinance of 1931 Amendment Ordinance 1934 it was enacted that for the period from the first day of November One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three to the thirty-first day of March One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six sub-section (c) of section 5 of the "St. James Parsonage Act" as amended by the "St. James Parsonage Act 1912" Ordinance of 1931 shall be read as if after the word "quarterly" the words "and a further sum less by £400 per annum reckoned quarterly" were inserted therein For the same period sub-section (d) of the same Act and section as amended by the "St. James Parsonage Act 1912 Ordinance 1931" shall be read as if the following words were added after the word "Hall" and a further sum of Four hundred pounds per annum reckoned quarterly to be paid to the Rector and Churchwardens for the time being of the Church of St. James Sydney whose receipt shall be a sufficient discharge to be dealt with in pursunnce of the Sydney Church Ordinance 1912 or any Ordinance amending or taking the place of the same and applied by them

towards maintaining the said Church and in or towards the payment of the Clergyman duly appointed to officiate at the said Church AND WHEREAS it is expedient to vary further the provisions of the "St. James Parsonage Act 1912" by further decreasing the share of rents and profits applicable to the purposes of subsection (c) of section 5 of the said Act and providing a sum to be paid to the Rector and Churchwardens of the Parish of St. lames for Parish purposes in manner hereinafter mentioned Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Act and by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and the "Land Ordinances Procedure and Delegation of Powers Ordinances" and in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Synod by the constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales or otherwise in the name and place of such Synod and with the sanction of the Archbishop of Sydney ordains declares determines appoints and rules as follows:--

- By reason of circumstances subsequent to the passing of the said recited Act and the 12rdinances thereon it is expedient to vary further determine and appoint the provisions of sub-sections (c) and (d) of section 5 of the said Act in the following particulars:—
  - (a) For the period from the first day of April One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six to the thirty-first day of March One thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight subsection (c) of section 5 of the "St. James Parsonage Act" as amended by the "St. James Parsonage Act 1912" Ordinance of 1931 shall be read as if after the word "quarterly" the words "and a further sum less by £400 per annum reckoned quarterly" were inserted therein.
  - (b) For the same period sub-section (d) of the same Act and section as amended by the "St. James Parsonage Act 1912 Ordinance 1931" shall be read as if the following words were added after the word "Hall" and a further sum of Four hundred pounds per annum reckoned quarterly to be paid to the Rector and Churchwardens for the time being of the Church of St. James Sydney whose receipt shall be a sufficient discharge to be dealt with in pursuance of the Sydney Church Ordinance 1912 or any Ordinance amending or taking the

place of the same and applied by them towards maintaining the said Church and in or towards the payment of the Clergyman duly appointed to officiate at the said Church.

- 2. This Ordinance shall be read as supplementary to the "St. James' Church and Parsonage Insurance Ordinance of 1916," "The St. James' Parsonage Act 1912 Ordinance 1928," "The St. James' Parsonage Compensation Fund Ordinance 1929," the "St. James' Sydney Parish Hall Ordinance of 1931," and "The St. James' Parsonage Act 1912 Ordinance of 1931" but shall in no way affect the provisions of the "St. James' Sydney Parish Sale Ordinance of 1935."
- 3. This Ordinance shall be styled and cited as the "St. James' Parsonage Act 1912 Ordinance of 1931 Further Amendment Ordinance 1936."
