
The Standing Committee (Amending) Ordinance 1930.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the "Standing Committee Ordinance Amending Ordinance of 1915."

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Constitution of the Standing Committee should be further varied Now therefore the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and of all other powers vested in the said Synod ordains and rules as follows:—

1. That the words "ten" and "nineteen" in line six of Section 1 Sub-section 2 of the "Standing Committee Ordinance Amending Ordinance of 1915" be deleted and the words "thirteen" and "twenty-two" substituted therefor.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Standing Committee (Amending) Ordinance 1930."
